



Rudbeckia fulgida (orange coneflower), which attracts a variety of bees (including the golden green sweat bee pictured here) and flies, small butterflies, some beetles, and seed-eating birds and small mammals, is **native to Virginia**. According to the *Digital Atlas of the Virginia Flora*, it is frequent in the Piedmont but infrequent in the mountains and inner Coastal Plain.
