



Coreopsis verticillata 'Zagreb' (threadleaf coreopsis) is a member of the Asteraceae (aster family), which has composite flowers. What appears to be a solitary flower is actually a **flattened disc bearing numerous tubular flowers** or florets with 5 short lobes crowded in a single receptacle surrounded by an outer ring of 7 to 20 slightly overlapping, ray flowers with blunt, 3-lobed tips. These flowers are arranged in an **inflorescence** called a corymb.
